Here are the options if you would like to sponsor/donate:

- Establish your own scholarships with a choice of your name (your company, parents' etc.) under Saharo Foundation. We will carefully pick talented and needy students. Minimum 5 scholarships annually. Cost is \$5,000/year, Minimum commitment is 5 years
- Sponsor a student in general \$1,000/year or any donation of your choice, no commitment
- Sponsor a family of 5, we will provide monthly rations to family, share receipts and videos with you. Cost is \$2,000/annual, no commitment

- Finance a handyman to establish business (carpenter shop, taxi, grocery store etc.) One-time cost is \$5,000 but you can donate any amount
- Donate for general fund so we can provide, skills training, medicines, buy wheelchairs, save funds for emergencies to families in the United States, and renovate homes for widows and elderly in Pakistan.
- Donate your volunteer work hours, we are part of all major databases and companies. Please reach out to your company and ask hoe can you donate hours or make a matching donation to the Saharo Foundation.
