Saharo Foundation 2020 Year in Review

Despite the year 2020's tests, the Saharo Foundation moved its mission forward - empowering and enabling underprivileged people. Historically, our donations have been at \$50,000 or below but this year we reached at \$94,300.77 in total donations from community and corporate donations. We invested over Rs.15 Million rupees in Sindh. Majority of the donations came from Washington D.C residents. The highest community donation was \$5,000 and lowest was \$10. The success of the Saharo Foundation speaks to the value in collective impact, a development which brings society together, in a structured way, to bring about social change. The thinking of shared impact necessitates group contribution, and a culture that have a sense of responsibility for the people in Sindh. Thank you for your support, and a very happy new year.
